## GOD HEALED THE PEOPLE

### **Bible Story: Numbers 21:4~9**

### **Read Together: Numbers 21:4~9**

Moses and the Israelites traveled in the wilderness. The people were impatient, and they complained. "We are going to die here. We don't like the food we have!"

God responded by sending venomous snakes that bit the Israelites.

The Israelites went to Moses and said, "We sinned by complaining. Please talk to God for us. Ask Him to take away the snakes."

God told Moses what to do: "Make a snake image and put it on a pole. When anyone who is bitten looks at it, he will recover."

Moses made a bronze snake and mounted it on a pole.

Whenever someone was bitten, that person looked at the bronze snake and recovered.

## [ The Story of the Gospel ]
