## [ Message Points: "God, Our Redeemer" ]

### 1. The story is about "love in action" of God and His people

- God's love brought them back to Bethlehem
- God used Boaz to save and show His love in action

### 2. God was in control of the life of Ruth

- Ruth waited and God worked.
- God shows His love in action in your life.

### 3. We are redeemed by God's grace

- God is our redeemer: he paid the debt of our sin
- Grace is getting what we don't deserve

<< "God is our redeemer. God is in control. Be still and see what God is doing". >>

## [ Summary ]

Naomi lived in Judah with her husband and two sons. There was a famine, so Naomi and her family decided to go to Moab. There, Naomi's husband died. Naomi's sons married women from Moab: Orpah and Ruth. Then Naomi's sons died. Since the famine was over, Naomi decided to go home to Judah. Orpah returned home, but Ruth clung to Naomi. Ruth said, "Wherever you go, I will go. Your God will be my God." Naomi and Ruth returned to Judah.

Ruth went into the fields to gather fallen grain. Boaz saw Ruth in his field. He had heard how she had been kind to Naomi. Boaz made sure Ruth was safe and had enough food.

Ruth went back to Naomi and told her about Boaz. "He is one of our family redeemers," Naomi explained. Naomi gave Ruth special instructions. Ruth showed Boaz that she hoped he would marry her. Ruth explained, "You are a family redeemer."

So Boaz stood before the elders in the town and made an agreement. He promised to redeem and marry Ruth. Ruth and Boaz had a son named Obed. When Obed grew up, he was the father of Jesse, who was the father of King David.

## [ Christ Connection ]
