## [ Memory Verse ]

John 14:6

"I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."

## [ Summary Story ]

John saw Jesus coming toward him and he said, "Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!" "This is the Son of God!" John said.

John's disciples heard this and followed Jesus. They said, "Teacher, where are you staying?" "Come and see," Jesus replied. So they went and saw where Jesus was staying, and they stayed with him that day.

One of the two who followed Jesus was named Andrew. Andrew found his brother Simon and said, "We have found the Messiah!" Andrew brought Simon to Jesus. When Jesus saw him, He said, "You are Simon, son of John. You will be called Cephas" (which is translated "Peter").

Jesus decided to go to Galilee. Jesus found Philip and told him, "Follow Me." Philip went to Nathanael and said, "We have found the Messiah. He is Jesus."

When Jesus saw Nathanael coming toward Him, He said, "Here is an Israelite who can be trusted." "How do You know me?" Nathanael asked. Jesus said, "I saw you, before Philip told you about Me." Then Nathanael said, "Teacher, You are the Son of God. You are the King of Israel!"
