[Memory Verse]

Galatians 5:22-23

"But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law."

[Summary Story]

Jesus and His disciples traveled through Samaria and stopped in a town with a well. While Jesus was at the well, a Samaritan woman came to get water from the well.

Jesus said to her, "Give Me a drink." The woman was surprised. "Why are You talking to me?" she asked. Jesus said, "I asked you for a drink. You don't know who I am. If you did, you would have asked Me for a drink, and I would give you living water."

The woman was confused. She said, "Where do You get this 'living water'?" Jesus said, "Anyone who drinks this well water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks from the water I give will never be thirsty again! Jesus was talking about the Holy Spirit, but the woman did not understand.

"Sir," she said, "give me this water. "Go get your husband," Jesus said. "I don't have a husband," the woman replied. Jesus knew she was telling the truth.

He said, "You don't have a husband now, but you've had five husbands." Jesus was right. "I see You are a prophet," the woman said. The woman said, "I know the Messiah is coming. When He comes, He will explain everything to us." Then Jesus said, "I am the Messiah."

[Discussion Questions]
